Sponsor Placement FAQ





What is the difference between an Enroller and a Sponsor?

Enroller - The representative that personally introduces a new Representative to 5LINX. A Representative who enrolls a Customer or another Representative into the Company, and is listed as the Enroller on the Representative Application and Agreement. An Enroller is eligible to sponsor place the new Representative anywhere into their direct downline organization, so long as the Sponsor is in the open line of said Enroller.

Sponsor - The Representative under which a new Representative is placed. A Representative who enrolls a Customer or another Representative into the Company, and is listed as the Sponsor on the Representative Application and Agreement. The enroller has the option to be both enroller and permanent sponsor by placing a new Representative on their first level. The enroller may also choose to place (permanently sponsor) a new Representative anywhere in their downline openline organization to help stabilize the organization. The act of enrolling others and training them to become Representatives is called "Sponsoring."

What commissions will the Enroller or Sponsor receive?

It is best to review the most current Compensation Plan. While not a requirement, in some cases it is necessary to be both the Enroller and Sponsor in order to achieve certain earned position promotions, bonuses, and/or commissions.
